General Information

Invitation

Ahmadis from other countries may also attend the Jalsa Salana New Zealand 2020 provided they bring a “Letter of Invitation” issued by New Zealand Jama’at with the attestation from their National Amir/President.

Non-Ahmadi friends may also be invited to attend the Jalsa Salana. However, it is very important that to obtain ‘Invitation Card’ in their name from the Nazim Invitations, so as to avoid any inconvenience at the time of entry.

Hospitality Period

The New Zealand Jamaat will be the host for a period of starting from 15th to 18th January 2020. Langar Khana will be running during the hospitality period to provide food to Jalsa Salana attendees.

Registration cards

Admission to the Jalsa Salana (Annual Convention)

Participants are requested to sign in with the Registration office upon arrival at the Jalsa Salana site.

Overseas Guests

Overseas Guests are requested to report immediately to the Registration Office on arrival in New Zealand to obtain their Registration cards.

Reception

Reception on Arrival in the New Zealand.

Auckland has one main Airport; Distance from Baitul Muqet is 11.4km. It takes 18 minutes drive to the venue.

Please inform Office Jalsa Salana about the date of arrival, flight number and other relevant information well in advance if it is difficult for you to make your way to the mosque.

Transport to and from the Auckland Airport

FREE CONVEYANCE will be provided to all guests arriving from abroad at Auckland Airport to Jalsa site during the hospitality period.

The members are advised to confirm return bookings before departing from their home country.

For the information of the local travel agents please contact information office.

Within the hospitality period if transport is required for return journey, please contact the Transport Desk/Jalsa Salana Officer in advance.

Guests staying with relatives/ friends are requested to make their own transport arrangements.

The salient features are as follows:

- In case, members use their own cars, they would be allowed to park their cars at Homai Train station, or any designated parking. No Parking will be available inside the Masjid Baitul Muqet except for the external guests or special pass issued by Afsar Jalsa Salana.
- The members are advised to apply for parking permit well in advance. All applications should be addressed to Afsar Jalsa Salana and come through their local Presidents. Please provide the following information. (1) Name and Tajneed Code No. (2) Car Registration No. (3) Disability proof.

Accommodation

It is humbly requested to the overseas guests to make their own arrangements for accommodation at hotels, guest houses or with friends and relatives as there is no accommodation available as such at Baitul Muqet.

Staying on Jama'at's arrangements

Guests who travel from abroad and are unable to make their own accommodation arrangements should inform the Jama'at New Zealand by 20 December 2019 so that they may be accommodated with Jama'at owned houses.

Staying at the Mosque

Out of Auckland members who will be staying at the mosque and are travelling by car are requested to bring their own linen, blankets and pillows. Only mattresses will be provided during their stay. Those that are intending to stay at the mosque should make their request to Afsar Jalsa Salana which should come through their local Presidents.

Private Tents

There is no facility to pitch tents at Mosque premises.

Hotels

A list of hotels around Baitul Muqet with telephone numbers appears in this guide.

Guests wishing to stay in a hotel are advised to arrange their bookings well in advance by contacting the hotel directly. The New Zealand Jama'at is unable to reserve hotel rooms on behalf of any individual member.

Meals

Lunch, Dinner and Tea will be provided from the Langar Khana to all attendees of Jalsa salana.

Breakfast will also be provided to the members and guests present on the site at the time.

Food Stalls

Snacks and other food items can also be purchased at food stalls situated within Baitul Muqet. The stalls will remain closed during the Jalsa proceedings and Prayer times.

Milk for Babies

Milk for Infants will be provided if required, under the supervision of Sadr Lajna New Zealand.

Other Information

First Aid / Medical Facilities

If hospital care is needed the guests will be required to pay the charges to hospital directly. For any medical aid or requirement contact Nazim Health and Safety.

It should be noted that the medical treatment is very expensive in the New Zealand. Members from overseas are strongly advised to ensure they have adequate medical insurance coverage during their stay in the New Zealand.

A written prescription is needed from a Registered New Zealand doctor before medicines can be bought in the New Zealand. If you are likely to require medicines in the New Zealand you are advised to bring a certificate from your own doctor indicating the nature of your illness and the medicines you are regularly taking. This information will be needed by the doctor before he will be able to help you in obtaining medicines.

Lost & Found Property

Nearest Railway Station.

Nearest Railway Station to Baitul Muqet (5 minutes walk) is Homai from where you can take trains to almost all destinations.

Lost Luggage
